Context

The following slides contain the aggregated results of all pupils that completed SATs in the 15 Talk for Writing Training schools across England.

The data covers 2016 to 2023. No results were collected in 2020 or 2021 due to the pandemic.

All figures in the charts are displayed as a percentage.

Context of the 15 schools in 2023


- Number of pupils in Year 6 = 846.
- 39% of children are Pupil Premium (Nationally 23.8%)*
- 42% have English as an Additional Language (Nationally 20.2%)**
- 21% children are categorised as having a SEND (Nationally 17.3%)*


2023 KS2 Writing Attainment EXS

Percentage of KS2 pupils writing at the expected standard




2023 KS2 Writing GDS

Percentage of KS2 pupils writing at Greater Depth




2023 KS2 Reading Attainment EXS

Percentage of KS2 pupils reading at the expected standard




2023 KS2 Reading GDS

Percentage of KS2 pupils reading at Greater Depth




2023 KS2 GPS EXS

Percentage of KS2 pupils using grammar, punctuation and spelling at the expected standard.




2023 KS2 GPS GDS
